

# HOW TO HANG A CHANDELIER

Simple rules designers always follow

## 1. HEIGHT OVER A TABLE

Hang your chandelier 30–36 INCHES above the table.

If ceilings are higher than 8 ft:

Add 3 inches per extra foot.

EXAMPLE:

8 ft ceiling = 30–36"  
10 ft ceiling = 36–42"



## 2. CHANDELIER SIZE

Your chandelier should be 1/2 TO 2/3 the width of your table.

EXAMPLE:

60" table  
30–40" chandelier



Prevents it from looking too small



Keeps balance in the room

## 3. FOYER / OPEN SPACE

If there's no table underneath:

Hang at least 7 FEET from the floor.

For tall ceilings:

Add 2.5–3 inches per foot of ceiling height.



## 4. CENTERING

Always center your chandelier to the table (not the room) or the visual focal point.



This is what makes a space feel "designer"

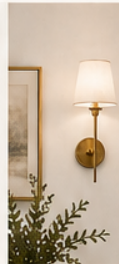
## 5. LAYER YOUR LIGHTING

Chandeliers should **NOT** be your only light.

Pair with:

- Wall sconces
- Table lamps
- Recessed lighting

This creates warmth and makes your chandelier shine.

**Pro Tip:** Take time to measure, visualize and adjust. The right height makes all the difference!
